SELF-CARRY EPINEPHRINE AUTO-INJECTOR PERMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

The law requires that an Epinephrine Auto-Injector be kept in the clinic as well as one with the student. The student must be properly trained and able to self-inject.

An Allergy Action Plan form must be completed for all students by the parent/guardian and physician.

In addition, **BOTH** the *Request to Administer Medication to a Student During School Hours* and *Authorization for Student Possession and Use of an Epinephrine Auto-Injector* forms need to be completed by the physician and parent in order to have self-carry permission. All forms requiring a physician's signature must have an original physician's signature. No stamped signatures will be accepted nor will any signature other than the physician's original signature.
